Gray, light brown, & black carapace (top shell)

Webbed feet

Concentric rings or ridges on the scutes (shell pieces)

Fan-shaped crest on its head that is black & white for a male & cinnamon brown for a female

Long, rounded tail WHO AM I?



Two thick white coats one short & dense and the other long & hollow

Straight black horns with a slight arc

Long narrow face with a short beard

## Rivers





Reddish or pinkish scales with silvery undersides & red fins

Large dark eyes

Black bar behind operculum (gill covering)

Black fur with prominent V-shaped white stripe

Tail is a mixture of black & white fur

Triangular head with small ears

Six legs built for jumping

Antennae longer than its body to sense well in the dark

Humped back inspired its name
